October 11, 2010

Perk Books can be sold by KBOA. The cost is \$7.50 per book, so there is potential for fundraising for KBOA by selling the books for more. Kimberly Fitness Center is the only Kimberly business in the book.

Plans for the Halloween parade were discussed. Mitzi will check with the City to map out the route and block off Main Street between Madison and Monroe. Lance, Connie, Cecille, Mitzi and Jamee volunteered to bring coolers for the hot dogs. Cecille is organizing volunteers to wrap the hot dogs.

The St. Nicholas Celebration was discussed. Jamee is working on collecting the \$5000.00 needed by November 27<sup>th</sup> for the fireworks. The City of Kimberly donated \$725.00. Kathleen is arranging for music groups from the school to perform. Everyone was asked to bring game ideas to the next meeting.

New Business:

Kickstand is meeting October 12 at Gertie's to discuss operating business during tough economic times.

KBOA has had inquiries from several individuals asking for more information. Lance and Heather will follow-up on these inquiries.

It was decided that new businesses would have a one year free membership. All current members will pay \$100 for membership no matter when they join during the year.
